Message from the CHAIRMAN

e are Grateful to God so far, He has led and helped us throughout the year 2021, the year started with uncertainty due to unrecovered challenges of the pandemic, which greatly affected our productivity and also the funding of projects.

In spite of the challenges we faced as an organization thank God for his unwavering grace. Amidst the challenges, we recorded a lot of advancement and achievements this year, to mention but few we were able to graduate and award certificate to our graduating students from the Rags to riches club, despite the fact that we had no grants and sponsors we singlehandedly championed the Child Marriage Campaign that held throughout a period of Six (6) months supported by KAS Prints and SI Magazine. This year, Beyond Mentor's Community Care Initiative (BMCCI) and Women Community in Africa (WCA) was recognized by different platforms and organisations. We recorded remarkable number of partnerships with other significant Organisations and individuals, we had volunteers and more members joining our platforms, we were also able to offer internship opportunities to some of our volunteers.

We launched a new Website for WCA and also inaugurated members of the General Assembly that coordinates activities of WCA. BMCCI was represented at different workshops and training with some significant organisations like CSACEFA, PLAC and WASCOF among others.

On different occasions We had some programs with the IDP women on Mental Health, menstrual hygiene, and early Child Marriage, we also partnered with NTA to provide visibility opportunities for other organisations on WCA through our platform. By the Grace of God Almighty WCA has metamorphosed into a coalition of Gender based Violence advocates as we ended the year partnering with UN on the 16 days of Activism, from 25th

November to 10th December 2021. We also applied for some grants that did not avail for some projects, thereby constraining us from accomplishing some of our projects and shifting it to next year.

Most importantly we were supposed to have a summit on the 25th day of November 2021 but due to constraints of funds and other issues we had to reschedule it to 10th of March 2022 to enable us prepare effectively.

As we approach a new year, we hope to have more opportunities and sponsorship to help us achieve the projects left unaccomplished and subsequently the new year's projects and Activities.


Thank you for a very fulfilling year, while we hope the following years will be more fruitful for us in BMCCI.




